When entering the city, follow the brown road signs for 'West Yorkshire Playhouse' at Quarry Hill, just off the A64 York Road in the centre of Leeds - or you can follow the City Centre Loop signs.

Major attractions, including the West Yorkshire Playhouse, are identified on the Loop signs. The Conservatoire is at Loop Junction 12.

There is no car parking available at LCoM, and drivers are advised to use the multi-storey car park on Harper Street.
